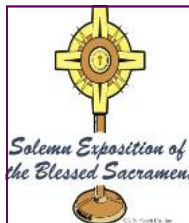

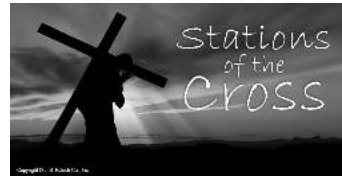


Marriage Tip

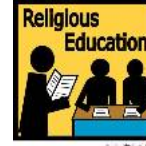
