



<u>PRAYER GARDEN</u>

The prayer garden ministry team invites you to an open garden tour with refreshments after Masses on Sunday, May 4th. The garden is open on Saturdays and every Sunday for a peaceful respite.

In 1985, artist Marianne Heames envisioned creating a prayer garden. The effort involved a wide diversity of artistic talents by parishioners. Our Lady of Guadalupe and story tiles were installed for the Feast in December of 1998. A centrally located statue of the Wedding of Cana portrays the moment in which Mary points to her son and says, "Do whatever He tells you."

Wall murals use four different art styles-Celtic, Mexican folk art, Traditional and Eastern. The murals on the west wall portray the baptism of Jesus, Jesus giving sight to the man who was born blind, the woman at the well, the miracle of the loaves and fishes and the washing of the feet. The rosary is laid out in blue tiles along the eastern floor. Along the western raised bed are 87 tiles that create a walking catechism beginning with the three theological virtues and ending with the works of mercy. The prayer garden ministry team waters, plants and prunes. Flowers and plants adorn almost every space and truly make the garden beautiful in all seasons.


