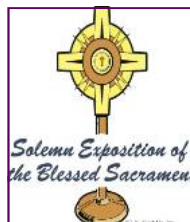

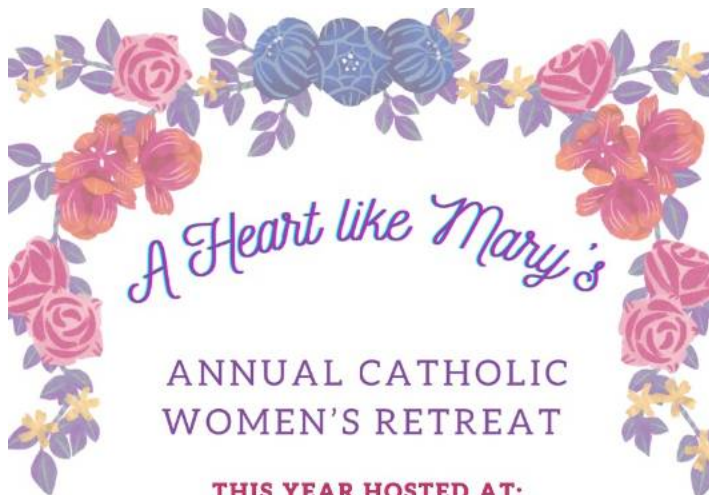


All Saints Catholic School School News!

If your student is receiving First Reconciliation/First Eucharist or Confirmation you **MUST** have a copy of the Baptismal certificate at time of registration.

Help is still needed if you feel called to share your faith with our young people. We are especially in need of a catechist for a combined third and fourth grade.
