#### The Society of St. Vincent de Paul: The Feast Day of St. Vincent de Paul

<u>DID YOU KNOW</u>: That the organization now known as the *Society of St. Vincent de Paul* had its beginnings in the Parish of Chatillon-les-Dombres on August 23, 1617. Father Vincent de Paul, responding to a family "in indescribable need," appealed for help in such vivid detail that his parishioners were greatly moved. Gathering some good folks who responded, he sought to explore ways to continue offering this kind of help. Thus, a few days later from this seemingly chance event, the first parish "Confraternity of Charity" was organized, becoming the pattern for a world-wide Lay Apostolate of the Church which now numbers some 800,000 members in 140 countries!

Blessed Frédéric Ozanam: The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) was founded 192 years ago (1833) under the patronage of St. Vincent de Paul, a beacon of Christian love and charity, to bring help to the needy and impoverished living in the slums of Paris, France. The primary figures behind the Society's founding were the Blessed Frédéric Ozanam—a French lawyer, author, and professor in the Sorbonne—and Sister Rosalie Rendu a member of the Daughters of Charity.

<u>DID YOU ALSO KNOW</u>? In the United States, the Society that *Blessed Frédéric* founded now totals more than 172,000 Vincentians in 4,600 communities! SVdP provides more than \$675 million yearly in tangible and in-kind services, serving more than *14 million* "friends and neighbors" in need.

<u>Our Lady of the Mountains Conference</u> serves those living in Zip code areas 85650 and 85615. Our conference numbers 15 Members and 7 Associate Members who provide a wide variety of services including a monthly "Rita's Food Pantry." During *Fiscal Year 2024-2025*, SVdP assisted 218 Households (612) people which included 49 Home Visits and 154 Other Visits (479 individuals). Rita's Pantry served 534 Households...1,905 people helped! All told, SVdP provided \$50,046.95 total monetary help to our friends and neighbors.

Blessed Frédéric discovered something profound: that in serving the poor, we not only give, we also receive. Vincentians seek to look after those who "fall between the cracks" of normal social services. With respect to the dignity of those we help, we offer a means of serving others.

On this feast day, we give thanks for Blessed Frédéric's life and legacy. We remember that our work is not just charity, but a vocation. Perhaps God is calling you to deepen your discipleship as a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society in Our Lady of the Mountain Conference. Ask any Vincentian about how you might become a member of this wonderful ministry of practical charity and service to others—to answer Christ's call to "love the least of these, my brothers."
