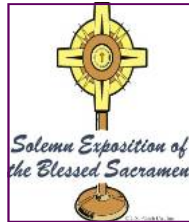

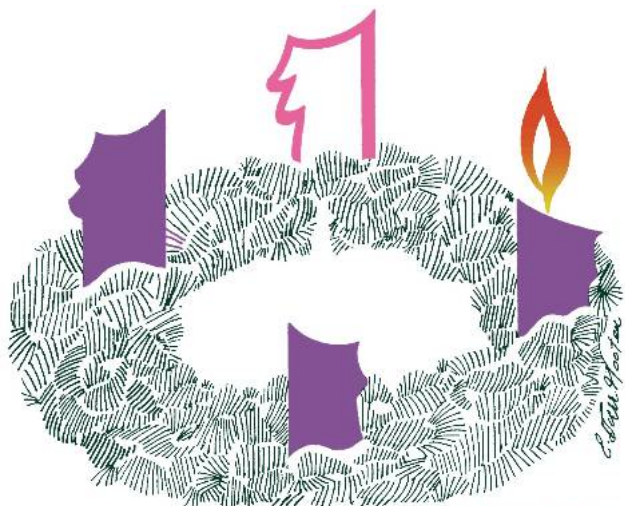
### Heavenly Treasures Gift Shop

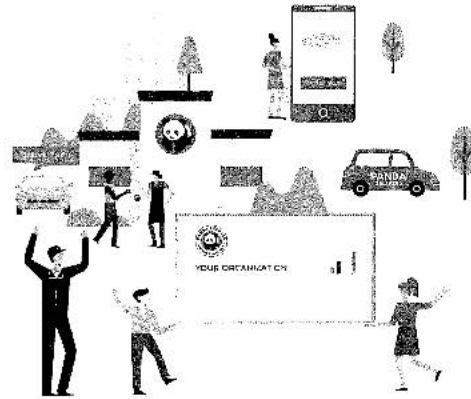

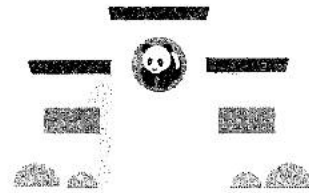
