





Vocations


"Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." (Matthew 4:4)





A Quick Questions and Answers Guide to Arizona Tuition Tax Credits

Q. Can I benefit from giving to CTSO?

A1. Yes, you benefit if you have AZ tax liability.

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): \$1,459

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,080

Your new tax payment due to AZ is now only: \$379

A2. You benefit even if you get a refund.

Your AZ tax withholding: \$1,800

Your AZ tax liability (your tax bill): -\$1,459

Your AZ tax refund (what you overpaid): \$341

Your tax credit to CTSO: -\$1,080

Your new AZ tax refund increases to: \$1,421

Examples assume single taxpayer with at least \$1,535 of AZ tax liability.

School Tuition Organizations cannot award, restrict or reserve scholarships solely based on a donor's recommendation. Taxpayers may not claim a tax credit if the taxpayer agrees to swap donations with another taxpayer to benefit either taxpayer's own dependent. See your tax professional for guidance.

Q. What if I don't yet know if I have any Arizona Tax liability for 2025?

A. To get an idea, check your 2024 taxes.
