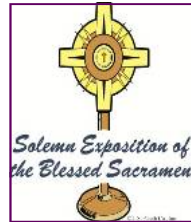

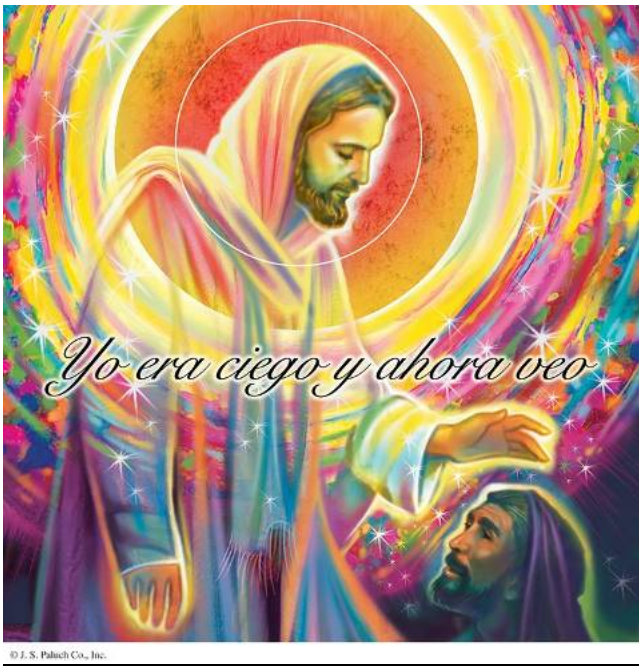

Our K of C members have met with and plan with the Care Net Pregnancy Center located at 1197 E. Fry Blvd, Sierra Vista, AZ 85635, 459-5683 of Cochise County.

Annually, we coordinate with Care Net and ask our OLM K of C members at church to hand out baby bottles on 11/12 April. On the set date (11/12 April (one month after distribution of bottles), the collection of the bottles (2-3 May) with the money before or after Mass. For people who forget their bottles, ask those to drop those at the parish office at their convenience (plan with the pastor for this).

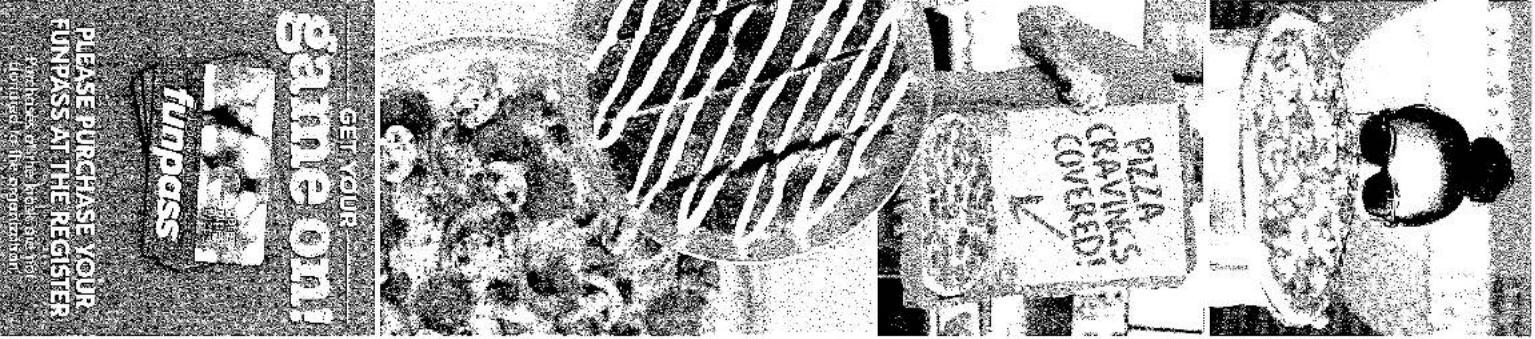

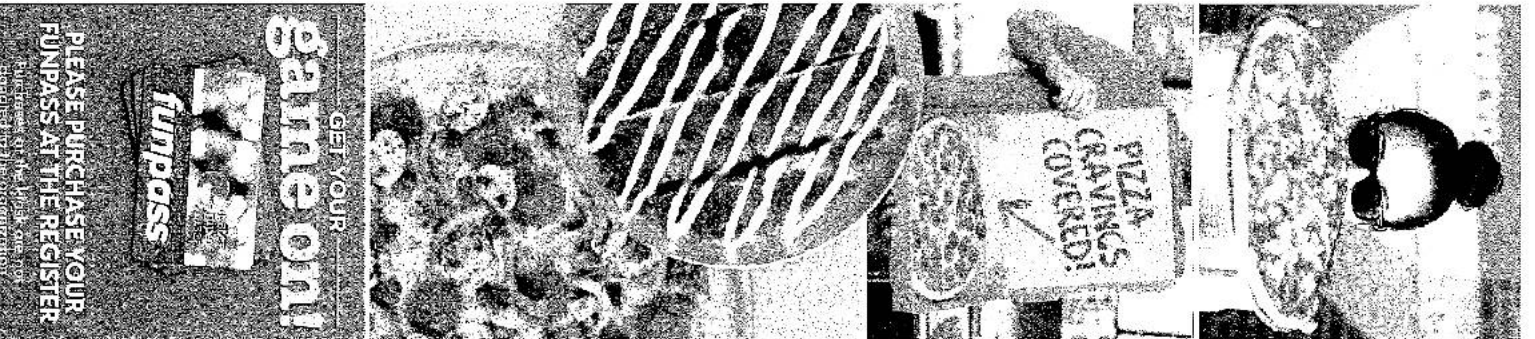

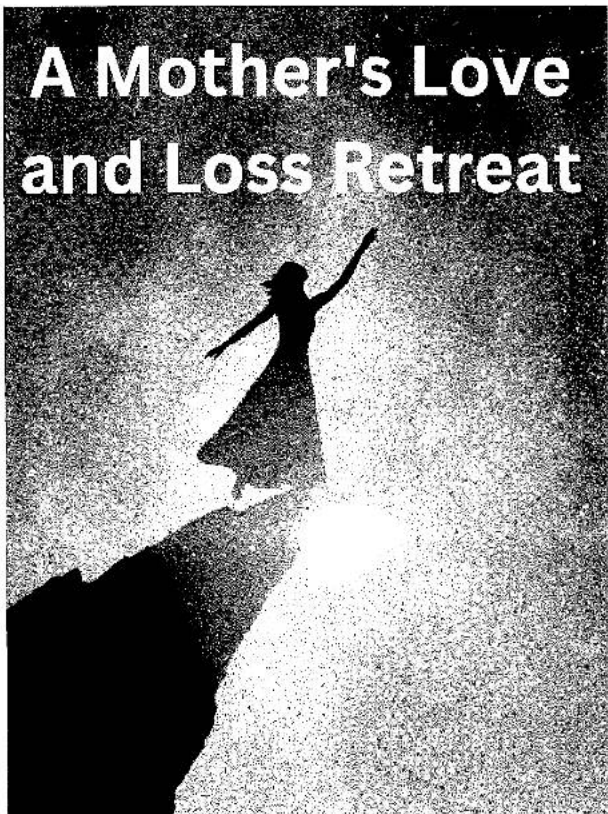
