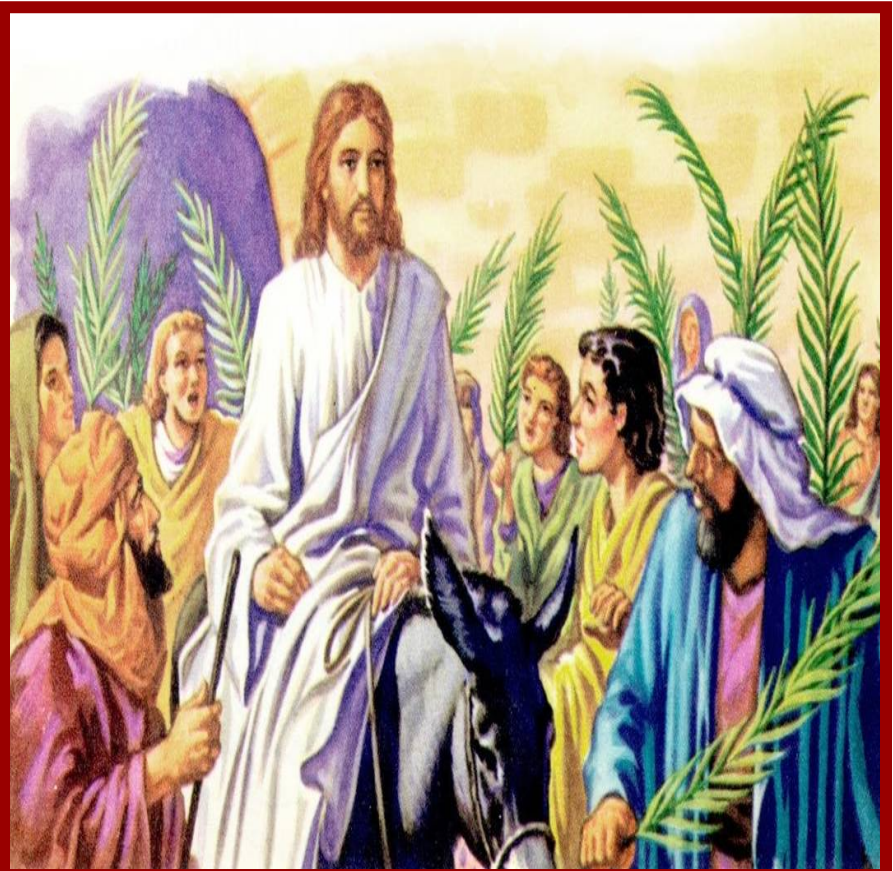

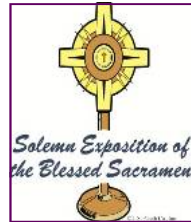

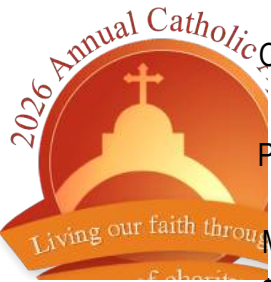

**Feast of Divine Mercy : Sunday, April 12, 2026**

**OLM's Mercy Sunday Celebration**

**2:30pm-3:30pm Eucharistic Adoration & Divine Mercy Chaplet**

**Ice cream social immediately after**

**“Turn to my mercy”**... words spoken by Jesus in private revelations to a simple, humble nun, Sr. Mary Faustina Kowalska, during the 1930's in Poland. As an uneducated, sickly nun, she humbly performed her convent chores of cook, gardener, and gatekeeper. She had frequent mystical experiences during which Jesus invited her to announce anew the gospel message of God's mercy.

Jesus requested His desire that His Divine Mercy be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. **“On that day I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who approach the fount of mercy.”** In preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy, Jesus requested confession, communion and a novena of prayers beginning Good Friday and ending on the Feast. **“You will recite it for nine days on the beads of the rosary..”** **“On each day you will bring to my heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of my mercy. On each day you beg my father for the strength of my bitter passion, for graces for these souls.”**

**Reciting the Divine Mercy Chaplet**

Our Lord taught Sister Faustina a prayer for mercy that she was to pray “unceasingly.” We too can pray this chaplet, using ordinary rosary beads of the five decades. We begin with the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostles Creed.

On the bead before each decade, pray: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Souls and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. On the “Hail Mary” beads, pray: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. After five decades, pray 3 times: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**The Novena of the Divine Mercy—Begins on Good Friday**

**First Day**

**Today bring to Me all mankind, especially all sinners, and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.**

Most Merciful Jesus, whose very nature it is to have compassion on us and to forgive us, do not look upon our sins but upon our trust which we place in Your infinite goodness. Receive us all into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart, and never let us escape from It. We beg this of You by Your love which unites You to the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon all mankind and especially upon poor sinners, all enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion show us Your mercy, that we may praise the omnipotence of Your mercy for ever and ever. Amen

**Second Day**

**Today bring to Me the souls of priests and religious, and immerse them in My unfathomable mercy.**

Most Merciful Jesus, from whom comes all that is good, increase Your grace in men and women consecrated to Your service, that they may perform worthy works of mercy; and that all who see them, may glorify the Father of Mercy who is in heaven.

Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon the company of chosen ones in Your vineyard—upon the souls of priests and religious; and endow them with the strength of your blessing. Amen.

**Third Day**

**Today bring to Me all devout and faithful souls , and immerse them in the ocean of My mercy.**

Most Merciful Jesus, from the treasury of Your mercy, You impart your graces in great abundance to each and all. Receive us into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart and never let us escape from It. We beg this grace of You by that most wonderful love for the heavenly Father with which Your Heart burns so fiercely. Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon faithful souls, as upon the inheritance of Your Son. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, grant them Your blessing and surround them with Your constant protection. Thus may they never fail in love or lose the treasure of the holy faith, but rather, with all the hosts of Angels & Saints, may they glorify Your boundless mercy for endless ages. Amen.

## Fourth Day

## Seventh Day

Most merciful Jesus, whose Heart is Love, receive into the abode of Your Most Compassionate Heart the souls of those who particularly extol and venerate the greatness of Your mercy. These souls are mighty with the very power of God Himself. Eternal Father, turn Your merciful gaze upon lukewarm souls who are nonetheless enfolded in the Most Compassionate Heart of Jesus. Father of Mercy, I beg You by the bitter Passion of Your Son and by His three hour agony on the Cross: Let them too glorify the abyss of Your mercy. Amen.
