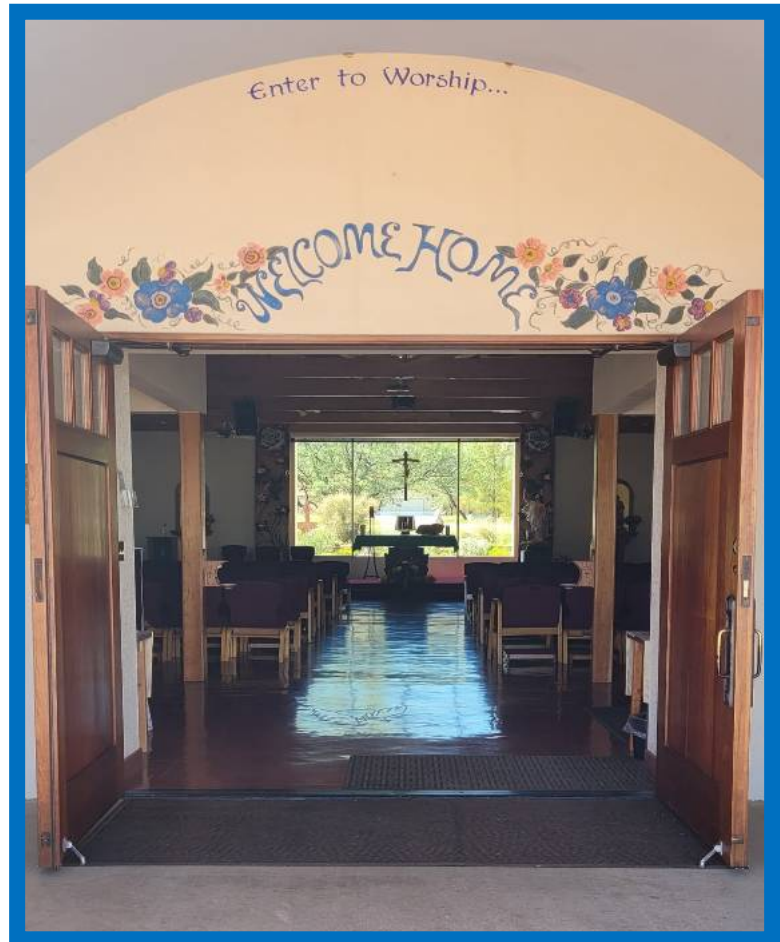

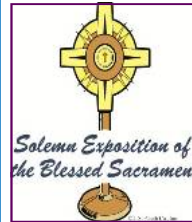

Heavenly Treasures Gift Shop

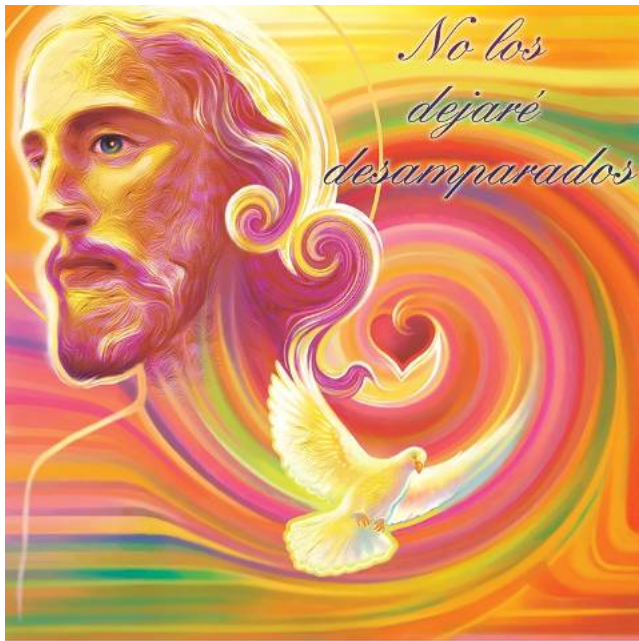
