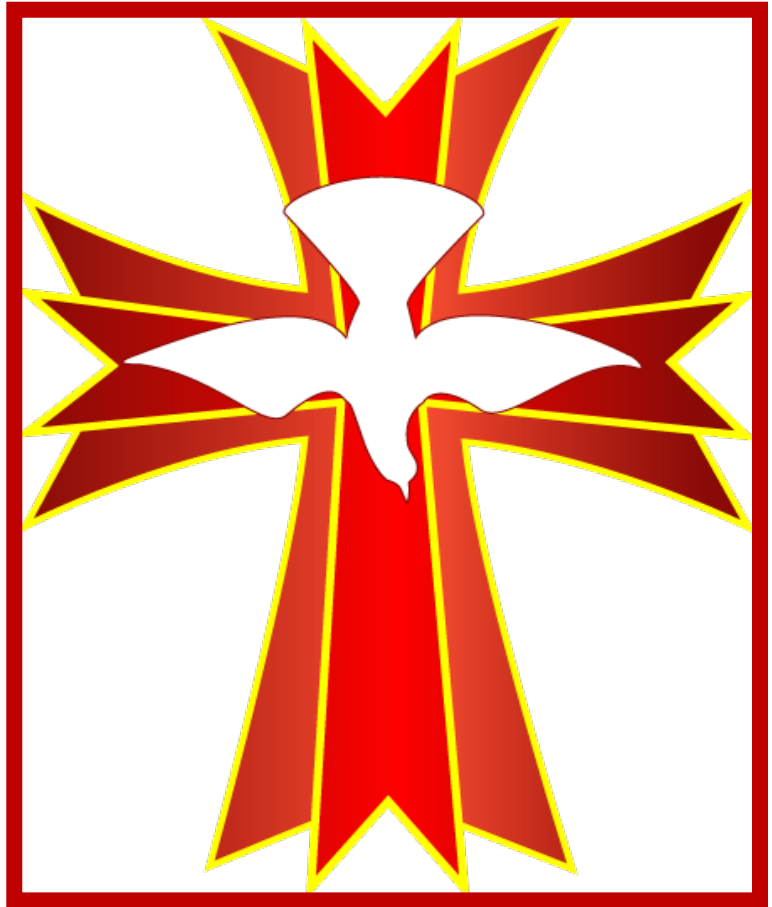

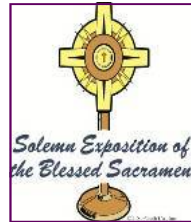

### CareNet Baby Bottles

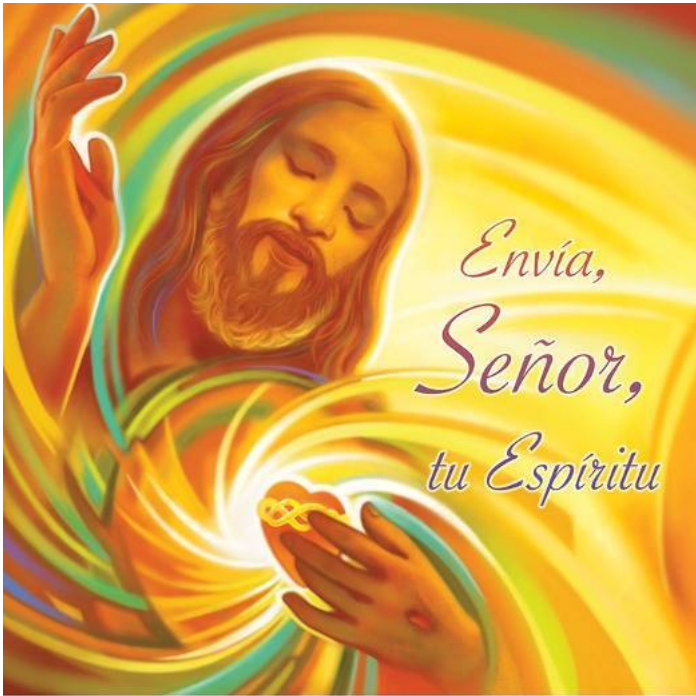
The Knights of Columbus continued to collect CareNet baby bottles this past weekend (only three received); however, there are 125 bottles still out.

### **Be filled with the Holy Spirit!**

I wish you the transformative power of the Holy Spirit during this Pentecost celebration. Pentecost reminds us that the Holy Spirit is not merely a distant theological concept. He is the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. Together with the Father and the Son, He is worshipped and glorified. As God's power, He spoke through the prophets and continues to speak through the church today.

The Holy Spirit is the gift of God the Father, sent to us at the Son's request. As the Lord, the giver of life, the Holy Spirit is the closest person of the Trinity, indwelling the church. He is the breath of our life, the fire in our hearts for bold love, the strength to forgive, and the courage that moves us away from fear and toward God's presence, transforming us into a courageous, spirit-filled community with a mission to proclaim and witness to God's kingdom. With the Holy Spirit, we know and live as a people transformed from the inside out!

The primary symbols of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost are wind and fire, representing movement, purification, and power. Furthermore, they remind us that God's role in our lives extends beyond mere comfort; at times, He refines us through challenges, eradicating fear and igniting our sense of purpose.

More significantly, Pentecost reassures us that the Christian life is never meant to be lived on our own strength or knowledge. Christian discipleship is a life lived by the strength of the Holy Spirit. It reminds us that discipleship is never meant to be lived alone, but in the solidarity of communion and the harmonization of differences. At Pentecost, the Spirit united all languages. Without erasing differences, He harmonized them, moving the apostles beyond uniformity to genuine, Spirit-filled unity. What He did to the apostles is not frozen in the past; the Holy Spirit continues to unite us today, helping us harmonize our differences and voices into a single, unified praise of the Holy Trinity.

Join me in celebrating this special day, the feast of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit (Spiritans). We are pleased to welcome Fr. Francis Okih, C.S.Sp., to mark this occasion—a celebration of God's power. As we receive him, may his message and call for support touch your hearts and inspire you to give generously to support our mission, life, and development of the Spiritans, Province of Nigeria, North East.
