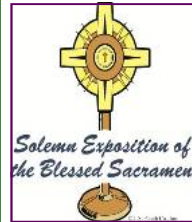

Attention Parents for Religious Education

Registration for Religious Education begins tomorrow, July 13. All children from Grade 1 through grade 8 should be registered even if the child attended classes last year.

There will be a parent meeting in the church hall on August 26 after the 5:30 Mass. Parents are invited to attend Mass and then proceed to the meeting. There will be some changes to the RE program so it is important for parents to attend.

If your student is going to be receiving a sacrament this year they need to have a Baptism certificate at registration.

Classes this year will begin at 5:00 pm and end at 6:30 pm. on Wednesdays. The first class will be held on September 2.

Registration for Confirmation classes also begins on July 13.

Confirmation candidates must have a Baptism certificate unless they were baptized at OLM. Students must be in 9th grade or higher to register for Confirmation. Confirmation is a two year course.

The festivities will commence with the inaugural Mass on July 18, officiated by our Bishop, James Misko, Bishop of Tucson, followed by the dinner.

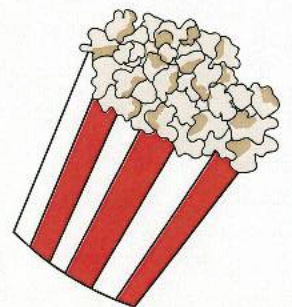
