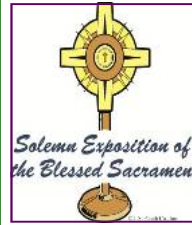

COMPLIANCE NEWS

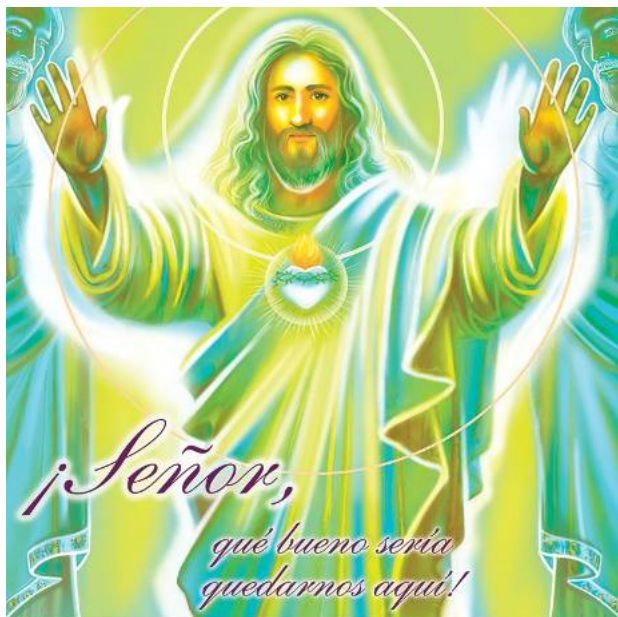

Attention Parents for Religious Education

Registration for Religious Education has begun. All children from Grade 1 through grade 8 should be registered even if the child attended classes last year.

There will be a parent meeting in the church hall on August 26 after the 5:30 Mass. Parents are invited to attend Mass and then proceed to the meeting. There will be some changes to the RE program so it is important for parents to attend.

If your student is going to be receiving a sacrament this year they need to have a Baptism certificate at registration.

Classes this year will begin at 5:00 pm and end at 6:30 pm. on Wednesdays. The first class will be held on September 2.

Registration for Confirmation classes also has begun. Confirmation candidates must have a Baptism certificate unless they were baptized at OLM. Students must be in 9th grade or higher to register for confirmation. Confirmation is a two-year course. Classes begin on Mon, Aug. 31 at 5:00pm versus 5:30pm

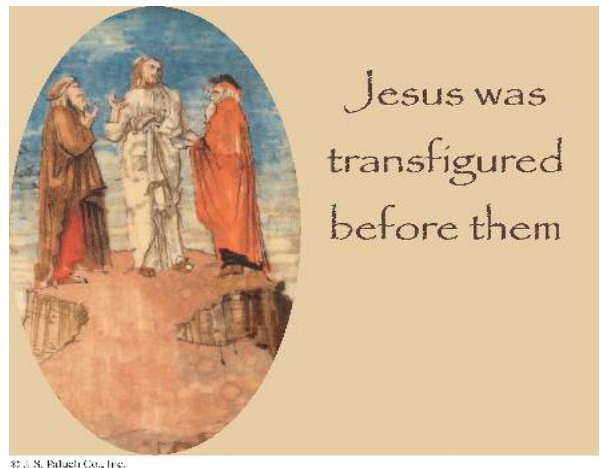

Ayman Khair is representing Christian families from the Holy Land. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the War tourism has been stopped completely.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no tourism at all. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles are beyond description.** Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income will be able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.
