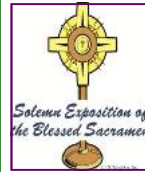

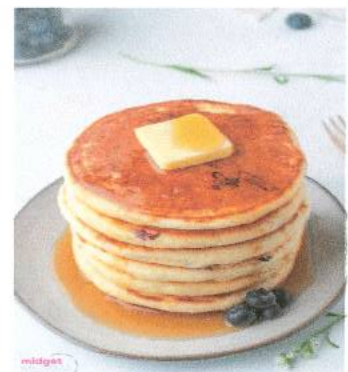

Our students walked in memory of FDNY Firefighter Stephen Siller, whose courage on September 11 remains a powerful example of selfless service. We walk in remembrance. We pray in gratitude. We serve in their honor.
