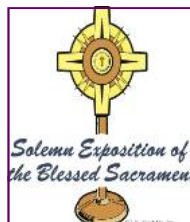

**Registration will be held after the Masses on August 3 or you can register at the parish office during office hours.**

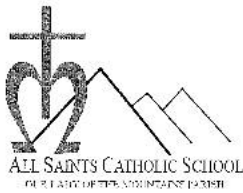

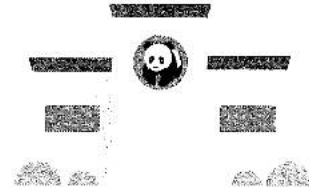
